



### Rules for the pre-selection of the annual Spelling Bee

- 1.) The student must spell 3 words given by the teacher at random. Each word is scored as follows:  
1 word: 10 pts / 2 words: 15 pts / 3 words: 20 pts.
- 2.) In case the student spells any word with a maximum of two errors, the total score will not be deducted.
- 3.) Once the student selects the number of the word, he gives it to the teacher and the teacher dictates the word: pencil. The student then says the word, spells it p – e – n – c – i – l, and finally repeats it: pencil.
- 4) Words containing spaces or hyphens must be mentioned by the student.

**Espacio ( ): SPACE / Guion (-): Hyphen**

- 5) Words containing capital letters must be mentioned by the student as in the example:  
**capital letter y luego menciona la letra. Ejemplo: capital letter “O”**
