

Bilingual Fair Report Guidelines

1st year

- The Report must be printed.
- Delivered on time.
- It must contain a development of all the points asked for in this document.
- The font must be Times New Roman. Size 12
- The Report must have a cover with the information of the institution, the year and section, a title (the name of the comic) and the name of the team members.
- You must deliver just one report for each group.

For this report the students must focus on three main points: The Plot for the first chapter, the general plot or general outline of the whole story, The world the story takes place in.

First Chapter plot: You're going to develop it by describing the beginning, development, climax and the resolution for the first chapter. In short, describe all the important, elements, characters and events that take place in this first chapter in a general way.

General story plot: You're going to develop it by describing the beginning, development, climax and the resolution in this case of the whole story. Beyond the first chapter. Focus on where you want your complete story to go to. To give you an idea think of the beginning, middle and end of your story in a general way.

The World: For this focus on the description of the world. The year it takes or time it takes place: past, present, future. The geographic characteristics, the level of technology, the existence or nonexistence of magic or supernatural characteristics. For this point you can ask yourselves some questions.

Does the story happen in the real world or an invented one?

Does it take place, in a big city, small city, a town, a forest, a mountain, a desert, etc?

How many people are in this world?

Does it have a social political situation that affects the story?

Are there animals, fantastic or invented ones?

Does the food grow easily?

Just like that you can ask many questions that will help you set the world your story will take place.
